

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students attending a McDowell County School high school shall have successfully completed the following program of study to be eligible to graduate. Students must successfully pass the minimum amount of credits required by West Virginia State Board of Education Policy 2510 to graduate from a McDowell County High School.

The school administration shall be responsible to administer this policy. All high school students shall attend high school full-time. The attendance requirements cited prohibits schools from permitting students to graduate before they have completed four (4) years in grades 9-12 and from allowing students to attend school for less than a full day, except to accommodate placement into college classes or any other extenuating circumstances. If students in any high school need or wish to attend less than a full day for any reason other than to accommodate placement into college classes, principals must request approval for the alternative arrangement.

Specific graduation requirements for students in McDowell County are outlined in the program of study that is published annually for students and parents.
