

REPEATING A CLASS

Students in grades 9-12 may repeat any class previously taken, provided that space is available in that class and no other student is prohibited from being enrolled. Credit may also be recovered through an online source such as Virtual Schools. An entire course may not need to be repeated if mastery of the content can be demonstrated by the student through an approved credit recovery course.

In calculating final Grade Point Average (GPA), the higher grade earned for the repeated class will be averaged and the lower grade discarded. The permanent record card will, however, reflect that the class had been repeated.

Specific rules for calculating GPAs for other entities/organizations, such as West Virginia Secondary Schools Activity Commission (SSAC), must be followed as required.

No additional credit can be earned by repeating a class.
