

CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION IN GRADUATION EXERCISE IN HIGH SCHOOLS

A twelfth grade student will be allowed to participate in the high school graduation ceremony if the following criteria are met:

- a. The senior has successfully completed the seven (7) previous terms of schooling and can meet the standards for graduation by successfully passing the eighth (8th) term's work.

and/or

- b. Any scholastic deficiency for graduation can be scheduled into the last eighth (8th) term's work, and the student will graduate by passing the courses scheduled into the last term.

or

- c. The senior has successfully completed Option Pathway program requirements.

or

- d. The senior has successfully completed Mountaineer Challenge Academy requirements.

The cap and gown and diploma will be ordered for all seniors who meet the stipulation above. Should the student fail to meet the graduation requirements in the final term, that student will be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony if, provided he/she agrees to complete the work on the remaining graduation requirements in summer school. The remaining graduation requirements shall not exceed two credits.
