

TITLE I PARENT INVOLVEMENT

McDowell County Schools will ensure the district and schools served under Title I jointly develops jointly with, agrees on with, and distributes to, parents of children participating Title I programs a written parental involvement policy annually that contains information required by section 1118(a)(2) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) (district wide parental involvement policy).
